Please forward the following information to Human Resource Services:

- Stage Student Request Form (available on www.kmhc.ca/careers)
- Student Name(s)
- Dates of the proposed stage
- Name of the school and program
- Department requested for stage (or field of study)
- Course objectives; if applicable
- The Human Resource Services will contact the relevant Service area to see if the stage can be accommodated.
- Once a decision is made, you will be contacted via email as to the status of your stage application.

To maintain the well-being of the clients, students may be requested to provide the Staff Health Nurse with their immunization records and meet with the Infection Prevention and Control Nurse. Students may also be required to complete a security check.
